Tool 5: Assessment of Network Management

Yes, the one with the faces

Symbol	Category	Explanation
	Good	Indicates that the item has been properly addressed and the team is satisfied with what is being done.
	Improving	Effort has been applied to the item but the situation is not yet as desired.
	Needs attentions	Indicates this item has not been given enough attention and corrective actions need to be implemented.

Tool 5: Assessment of Network Management

- 17 Network functions organized in three dimensions:
 - Network management (3 categories, 7 questions)
 - Network competence (2 categories, 7 questions)
 - Delivery of capacity building (1 category, 3 questions)

Group work (questions assigned to various groups if needed)

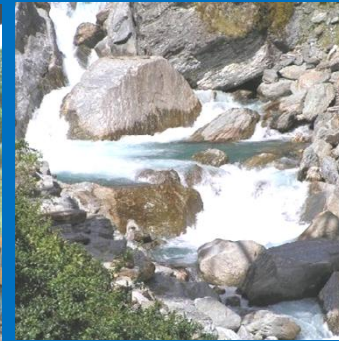
1. Is this tool still representative for us? Yes / No, why? Is it useful?
